tance and then more closely.

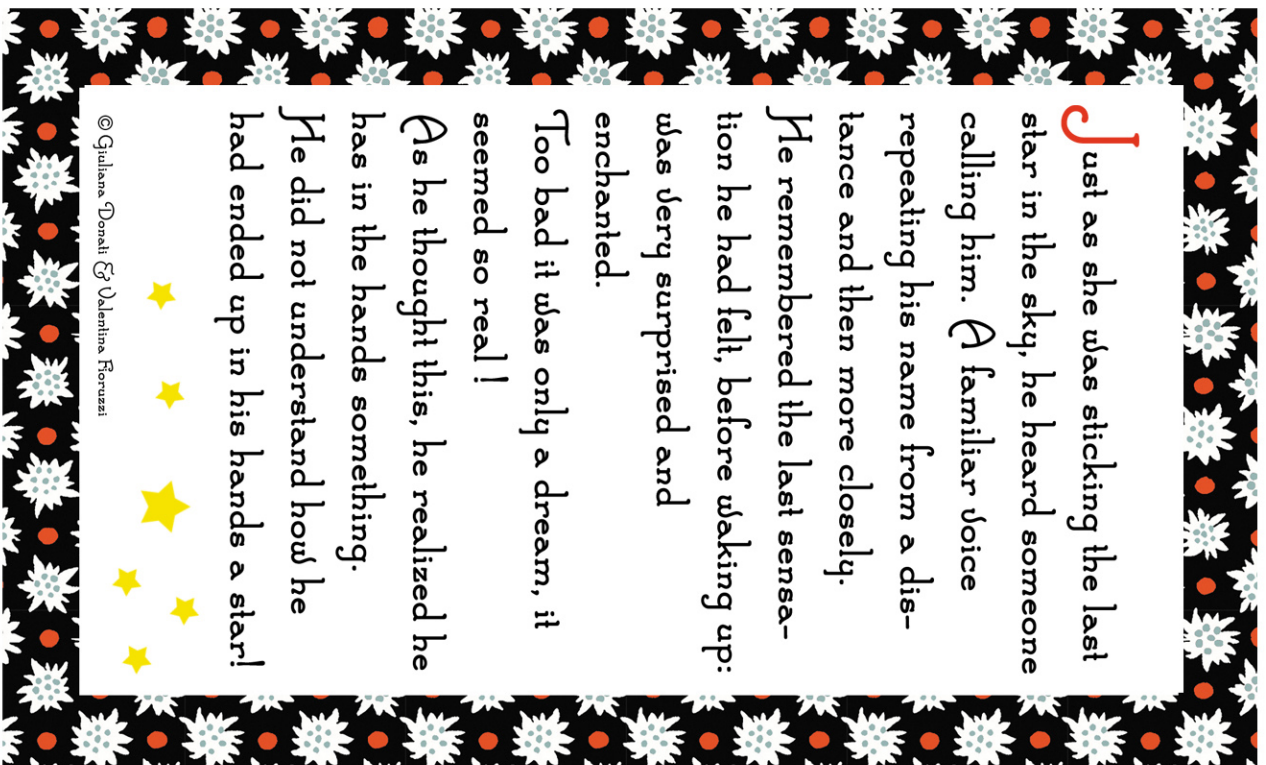
He remembered the last sensa-
